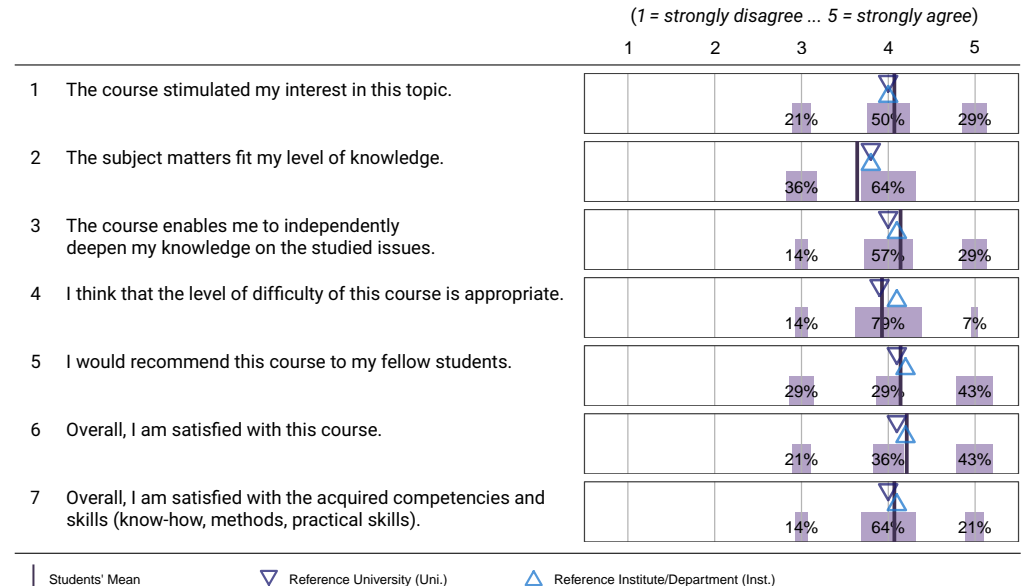

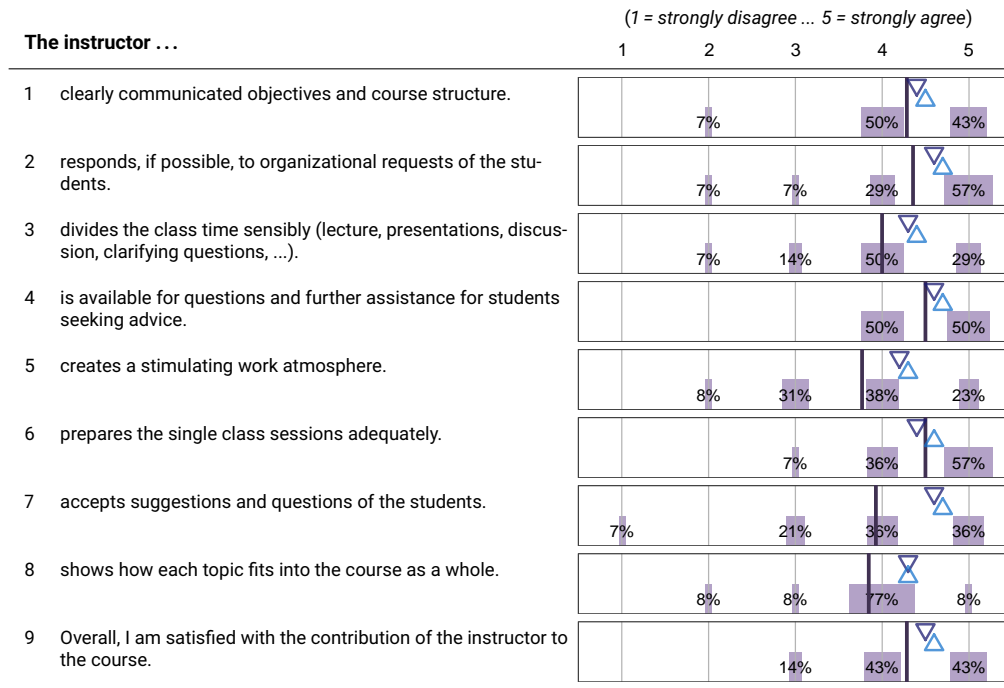

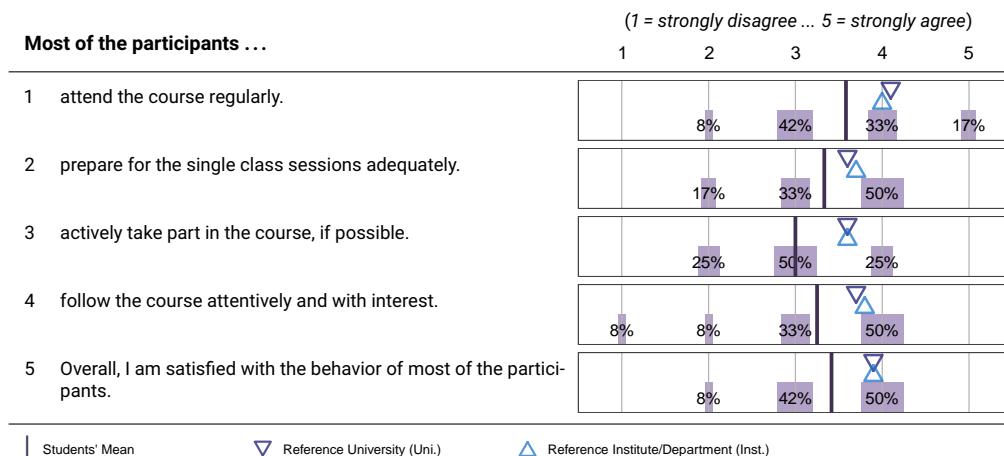

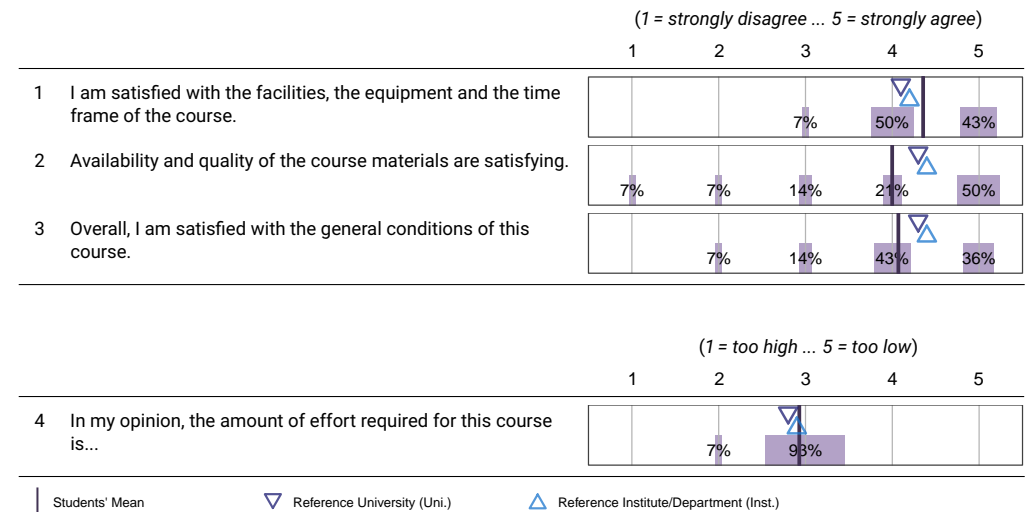
## Input of Instructor
