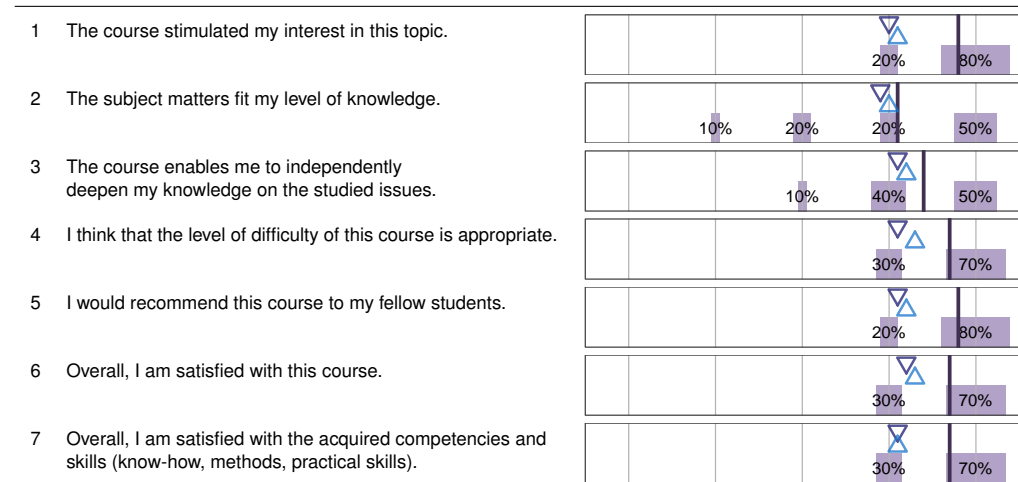

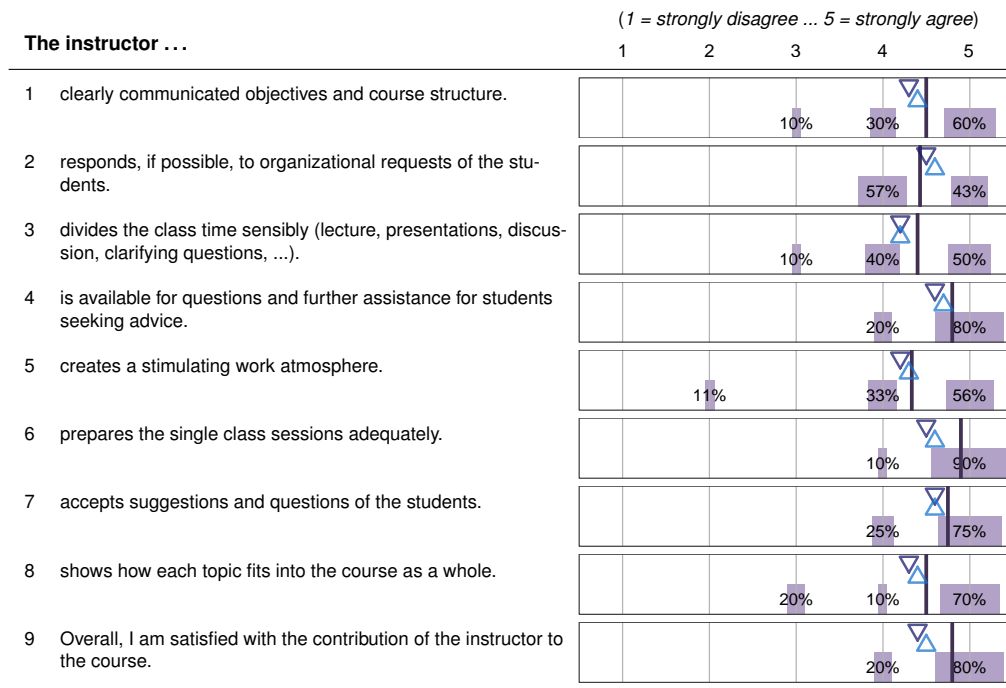


Students' Mean

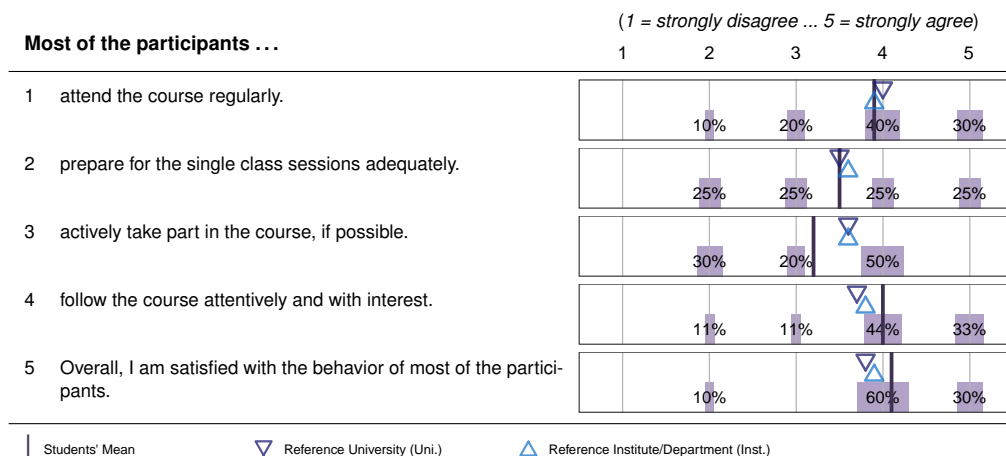

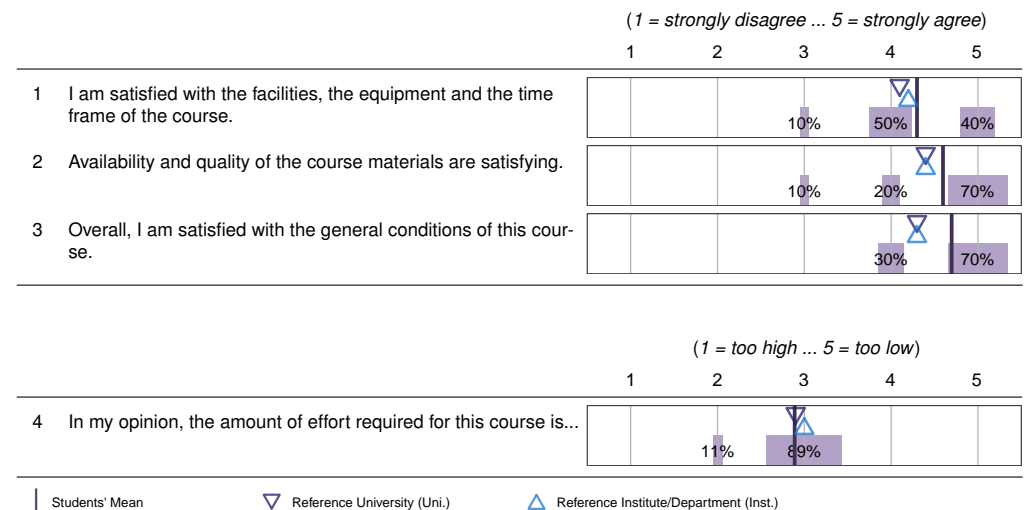
Input of Instructor
